

# Changes to train times



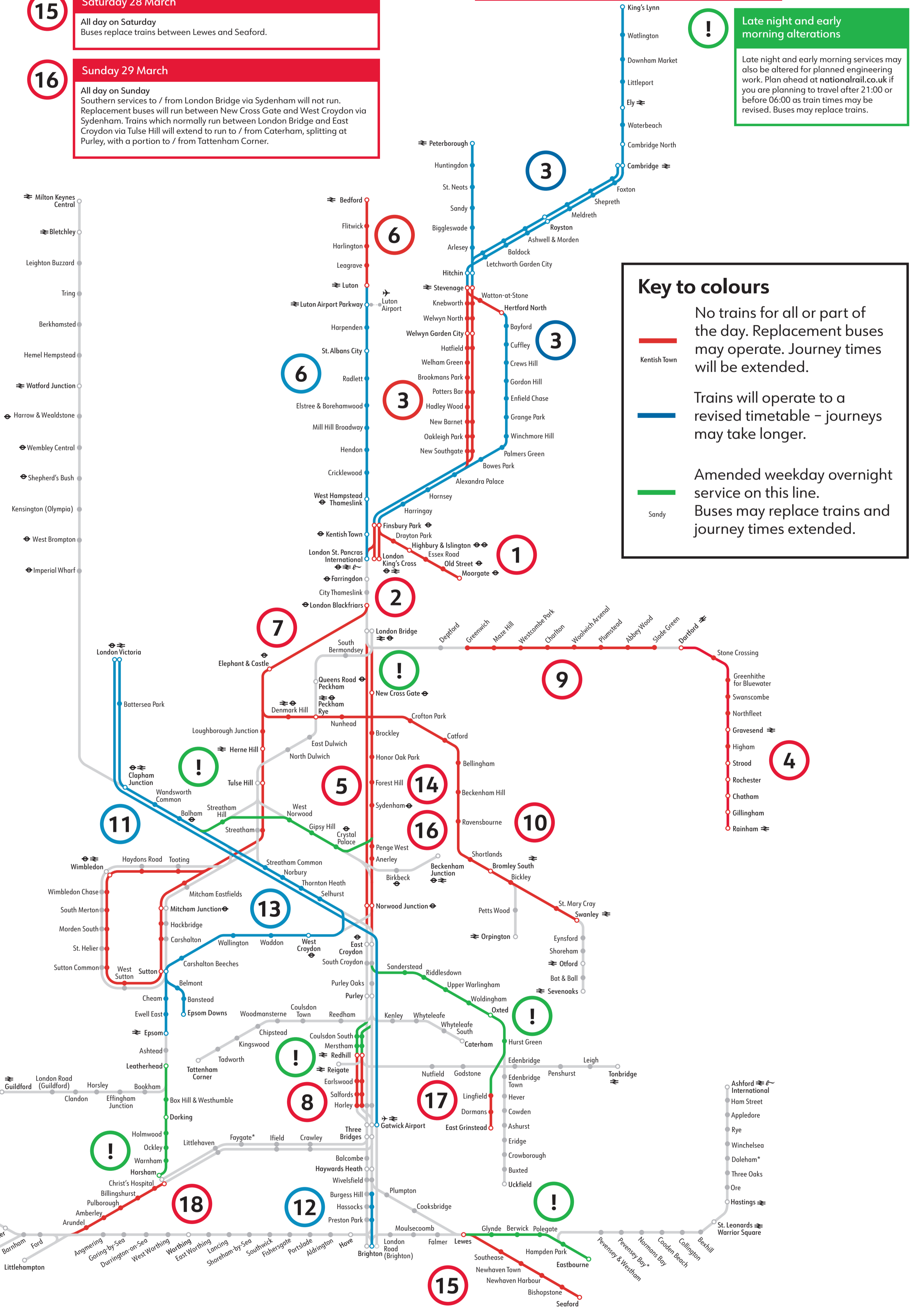
Monday 23 to Sunday 29 March 2020

## Planned engineering work and other timetable alterations

- 1** **Saturday 28 to Sunday 29 March**  
All day on Saturday and Sunday  
No trains will operate between Finsbury Park and Moorgate. Services to / from Moorgate will be diverted to / from London King's Cross. Use London Buses / Underground between Finsbury Park and Moorgate.
- 2** **Sunday 29 March**  
Until approximately 08:45 on Sunday  
No trains between Finsbury Park and London King's Cross. Use London Underground between Finsbury Park and London King's Cross.  
Great Northern stopping services will be reduced between Alexandra Palace and Finsbury Park.
- 3** **Sunday 29 March**  
All day on Sunday  
Trains between Cambridge / King's Lynn / Peterborough and London will be diverted to run via Hertford North with extended journey times.  
Buses replace trains between Alexandra Palace and Stevenage via Welwyn Garden City.  
Buses will replace all stations trains between Hertford North and Stevenage. Revised service between Hertford North and London King's Cross.
- 4** **Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 March**  
All day on Saturday and Sunday  
Trains to / from Rainham will start / terminate at Dartford. Use alternative Southeastern bus and train services between Dartford and Rainham.
- 5** **Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 March**  
All day on Saturday and Sunday  
No Thameslink services between East Croydon and London Bridge. Trains between Brighton and Bedford / Cambridge will not stop at London Bridge. Trains between Horsham and Peterborough will be split, running between Horsham and London Blackfriars / London King's Cross and Peterborough. Customers for London Bridge can use London Buses / Underground on all reasonable routes.  
Revised service between Bedford and London St Pancras. Trains between Luton / St Albans City and Sutton via Mitcham Junction will not run. For stations via Mitcham Junction, use London Buses to complete your journey. Reduced service between Bedford and Gatwick Airport.
- 6** **Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 March**  
From 22:00 until approximately 23:45 on Saturday  
A reduced service will operate between London St Pancras International and Bedford.  
From approximately 23:45 on Saturday and all day on Sunday  
Buses will replace trains between Luton and Bedford.  
All day on Sunday  
Trains between Luton and Sutton via Wimbledon will start / terminate at St Albans City.
- 7** **Saturday 28 March**  
From 22:00 on Saturday until the end of service  
No trains will operate between London Blackfriars and Sutton.
- 8** **Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 March**  
From approximately 23:45 on Saturday and all day on Sunday  
Trains will be unable to call at Earlswood or Salfords. Replacement buses will operate between Redhill and Horley.
- 9** **Sunday 29 March**  
Until approximately 08:45 on Sunday morning  
Thameslink trains will be diverted via Bexleyheath, and will not call at stations between Slade Green and Greenwich.  
Trains will call additionally at Lewisham, Blackheath, Eltham, Bexleyheath and Barnehurst. Replacement buses will operate via Greenwich.
- 10** **Sunday 29 March**  
All day on Sunday  
Sevenoaks services will run between Sevenoaks and Swanley only, with replacement buses between Swanley and Herne Hill.
- 11** **Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 March**  
From approximately 23:45 on Saturday and all day on Sunday  
Gatwick Express will run a reduced half hourly service between Gatwick Airport and London Victoria.
- 12** **Saturday 28 March**  
The 01:10 London Victoria to Brighton service will have an extended journey time between Burgess Hill and Brighton.
- 13** **Saturday 28 March**  
All day on Saturday  
A reduced service will operate between London Victoria and Sutton / Epsom Downs. Trains between East Croydon and Milton Keynes Central will run between Clapham Junction and Milton Keynes Central only.

- 14** **Saturday 28 March**  
All day on Saturday  
Southern services to / from London Bridge via Sydenham will not run. Replacement buses will run between New Cross Gate and West Croydon via Sydenham.  
Trains between Uckfield and London Bridge will run between Uckfield and East Croydon only.  
Trains between London Bridge and Caterham / Tottenham Corner will run half-hourly, splitting at Purley with some carriages running to / from Caterham and the rest to / from Tottenham Corner. These trains will run via Tulse Hill and Streatham.
- 15** **Saturday 28 March**  
All day on Saturday  
Buses replace trains between Lewes and Seaford.
- 16** **Sunday 29 March**  
All day on Sunday  
Southern services to / from London Bridge via Sydenham will not run. Replacement buses will run between New Cross Gate and West Croydon via Sydenham. Trains which normally run between London Bridge and East Croydon via Tulse Hill will extend to run to / from Caterham, splitting at Purley, with a portion to / from Tottenham Corner.

- 17** **Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 March**  
All day on Saturday and Sunday  
Buses replace trains between Lingfield and East Grinstead.
- 18** **Sunday 29 March**  
All day on Sunday  
All-stations replacement buses will run between Horsham and Littlehampton. Trains between London Victoria and Bognor Regis / Portsmouth Harbour will run between London Victoria and Littlehampton only.  
Trains between London Victoria and Littlehampton via Haywards Heath will divide at Worthing with some carriages running to/from Portsmouth Harbour.



**Key to colours**

- No trains for all or part of the day. Replacement buses may operate. Journey times will be extended.
- Trains will operate to a revised timetable - journeys may take longer.
- Amended weekday overnight service on this line. Buses may replace trains and journey times extended.

**Late night and early morning alterations**

Late night and early morning services may also be altered for planned engineering work. Plan ahead at [nationalrail.co.uk](http://nationalrail.co.uk) if you are planning to travel after 21:00 or before 06:00 as train times may be revised. Buses may replace trains.
