## Suggested alternative route details from Cheam

### Southern ticket holders

To: Suggested routes:

The bus stops for bus 470 to Sutton is on Station Way (stop E).

The bus stops for bus 470 to Epsom is on Ewell Road (stop B).

The bus stops for bus 151, 213 and X26 are on the Broadway (stops C and D).

Ashtead Bus 470 from stop B to Epsom, then South Western Railway train or bus 21, 408 or 479 to Ashtead

Balham Bus 470 from stop E to Morden station then Northern line to Balham

Boxhill & Westhumble Bus 470 from stop B to Epsom, then South Western Railway train direct (limited service) OR South Western Railway train or bus 21, 408 or 479 to Leatherhead, then bus 465 to Boxhill & Westhumble

Carshalton Bus X26 from stop C to Carshalton High Street (short walk to Carshalton station)

Carshalton Beeches Bus 470 from stop E to Sutton station, then bus S3 to near Carshalton Beeches station (alight S3 bus at Banstead Road/Downside Road)

Clapham Junction Bus 151, 213 or X26 from stop D to Worcester Park station, then South Western Railway train to Clapham Junction

Dorking Bus 470 from stop B to Epsom, then South Western Railway train direct or bus 21, 408 or 479 to Leatherhead, then bus 465 to Dorking station

Epsom Bus 470 from stop B to Epsom

Ewell East Bus 470 from stop B to Ewell East

Hackbridge Bus 151 from stop C to Hackbridge

Holmwood See how to get to Dorking, then bus 93 to Holmwood

Horsham See how to get to Dorking, then bus 93 to Horsham

Leatherhead Bus 470 from stop B to Epsom, then South Western Railway train or bus 21, 408 or 479 to Leatherhead

London Bridge Bus 470 from stop E to Morden station then Northern line to London Bridge

London Victoria See how to get to Clapham Junction, then Southern train to London Victoria

Mitcham Eastfields See how to get to Sutton then bus S1 or 280 to Mitcham Eveline Road.

Mitcham Junction See how to get to Sutton then bus S1 to Mitcham Junction

Norbury Bus X26 from stop C to West Croydon then bus 50, 109 or 250 to Norbury

Ockley See how to get to Dorking, then bus 93 to Capel village (for Ockley station)

Selhurst Bus X26 from stop C to West Croydon then bus 75 or 157 to Selhurst

Streatham Common Bus X26 from stop C to West Croydon then bus 50, 60, 109 or 250 to Streatham Common

Sutton Bus 470 from stop E, or bus 151, 213 or X26 from stop C to Sutton Centre, for Sutton station

Thornton Heath Bus X26 from stop C to West Croydon then bus 50, 198, 250 or 450 to Thornton Heath

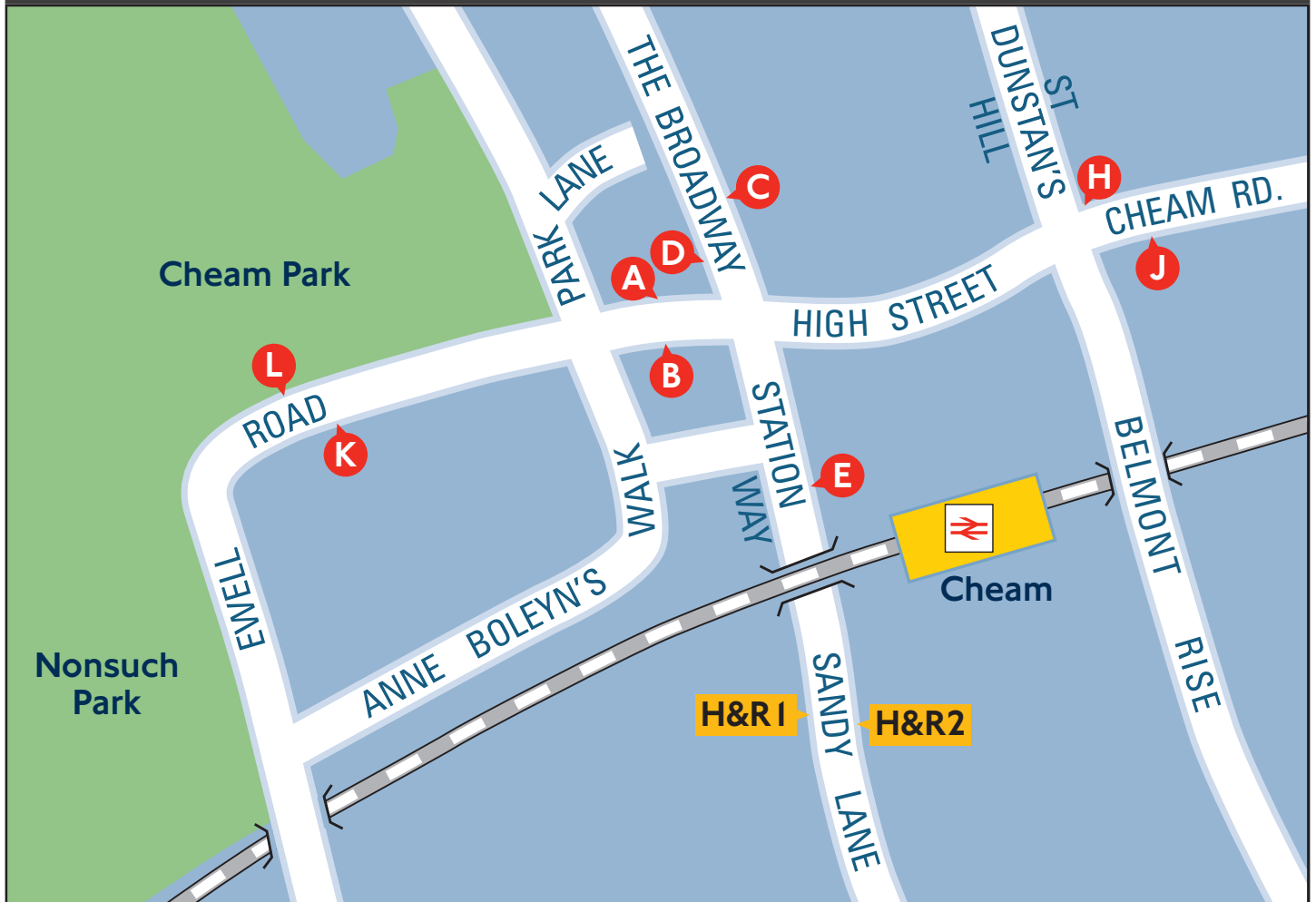
Waddon Bus X26 from stop C to Waddon

Wallington Bus 151 from stop C, or bus X26 from stop C to Wallington Green (short walk to Wallington station)

Warnham See how to get to Dorking, then bus 93 to Warnham village

West Croydon Bus X26 from stop C to West Croydon

#### Trains:

#### Buses:

- Brighton & Hove on any reasonable route
- London Buses on all appropriate routes within the Transport for London boundary

- Stagecoach Coastliner route 700 depending on the location of the disruption
