Anerley See how to get to West Croydon then London Overground train to Anerley

Balham See how to get to Purley or East/West Croydon then Southern train to Balham

Battersea Park See how to get to Purley or East/West Croydon then Southern train to Battersea Park

Brockley See how to get to West Croydon then London Overground train to Brockley

Caterham Bus 407 from stop C opposite The Kenley Hotel on Godstone Road to Caterham

Clapham Junction See how to get to Purley or East/West Croydon then Southern train to Clapham Junction

East Croydon Bus 407 from stop N outside shops on Godstone Road to Croydon town centre (alight at Fairfield Halls) OR see how to get to Purley, then Southern or Thameslink train to East Croydon

Forest Hill See how to get to West Croydon then London Overground train to Forest Hill

Honor Oak Park See how to get to West Croydon then London Overground train Honor Oak Park

London Bridge See how to get to Purley or East/West Croydon then Southern train to London Bridge

London Victoria See how to get to Purley or East/West Croydon then Southern train to London Victoria

New Cross Gate See how to get to West Croydon then London Overground train to New Cross Gate

Norbury See how to get to Purley or East/West Croydon then Southern train to Norbury

Norwood Junction See how to get to West Croydon then Southern or London Overground train to Norwood Junction

Penge West See how to get to West Croydon then London Overground train to Penge West

Purley Bus 434 from stop opposite station entrance on Kenley Lane OR bus 407 from stop N outside shops on Godstone Road to Purley

Purley Oaks Bus 407 from stop N outside shops on Godstone Road to Purley Oaks (alight bus on Brighton Road)

Selhurst See how to get to Purley or East/West Croydon then Southern train to Selhurst

South Croydon Bus 407 from stop N outside shops on Godstone Road to South Croydon

Streatham Common See how to get to Purley or East/West Croydon then Southern train to Streatham Common

Sydenham See how to get to West Croydon then London Overground train to Sydenham

Thornton Heath See how to get to Purley or East/West Croydon then Southern train to Thornton Heath

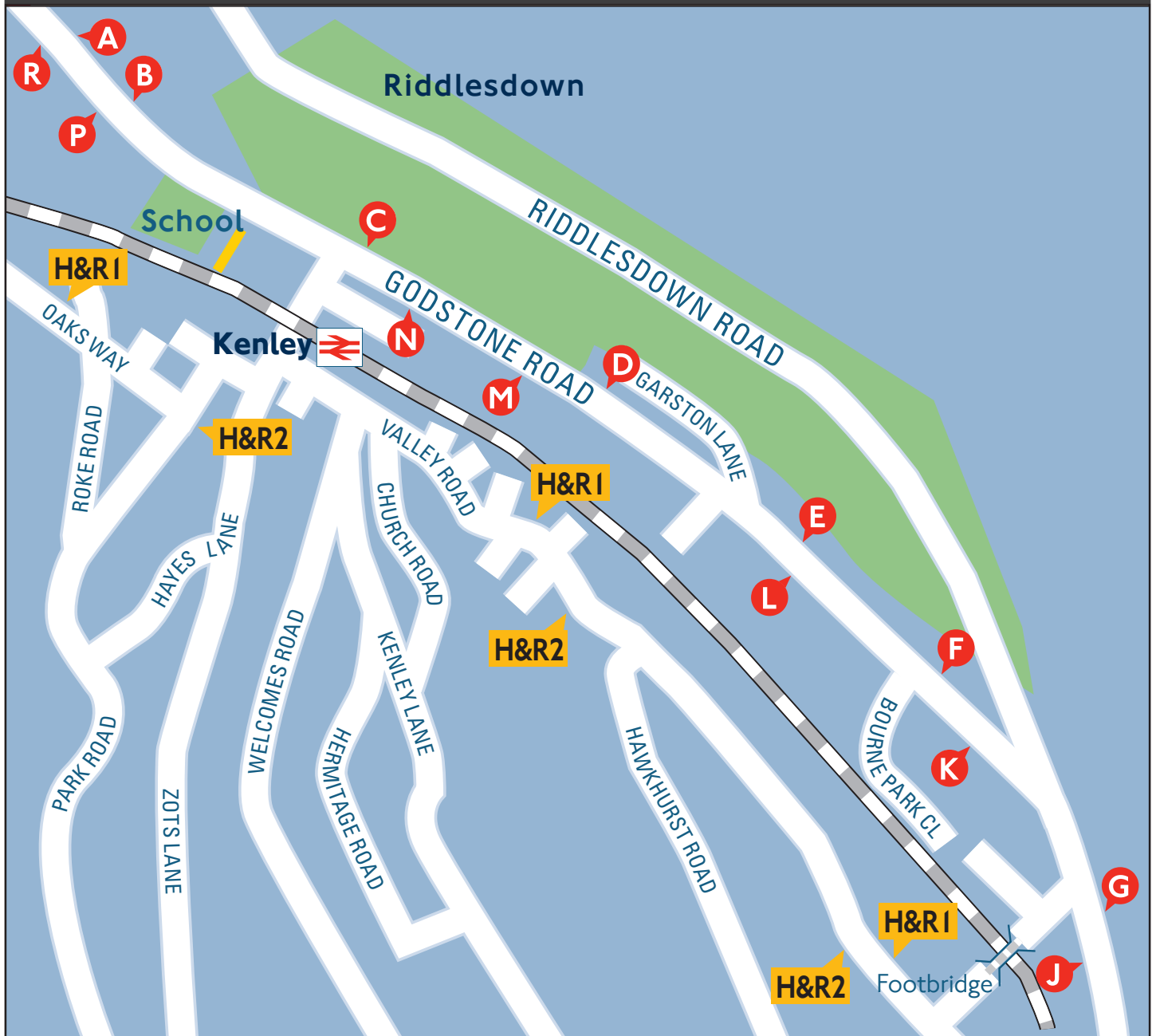
Wandsworth Common See how to get to Purley or East/West Croydon then Southern train to Wandsworth Common

West Croydon Bus 407 from stop N outside shops on Godstone Road (alight at West Croydon Bus Station), OR see how to get to Purley, then Southern or Thameslink train to East Croydon station, then walk or take the Tramlink to West Croydon

Whyteleafe Bus 434 from stop adjacent station entrance on Kenley Lane OR bus 407 from stop C opposite The Kenley Hotel on Godstone Road to near Whyteleafe station

Whyteleafe South Bus 407 from stop C opposite The Kenley Hotel on Godstone Road to Whyteleafe South station
