Berwick	Bus 125 (limited service) from the Bus Station to Berwick village
Bexhill	Bus 28, 29 or 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne then bus 99 to Bexhill
Bishopstone	Bus 123 (limited service) from stop A to Newhaven then bus 12 or 12A OR bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street) then bus 12 or 12A to Bishopstone
Brighton	Bus 28, 29 or 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), then bus 7 or 27 to Brighton station (you may also alight bus 28/29/29B at St Peter's Church, then walk 5 minutes via Trafalgar Street to Brighton station)
Clapham Junction	See how to get to Brighton station, then Southern train to Clapham Junction
Collington	Bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne, then bus 99 to Collington
Cooden Beach	Bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne, then bus 99 to Little Common (15 minutes walk to Cooden Beach station via Cooden Sea Road)
Cooksbridge	Bus 121 or 122 (limited service) from stop C to Cooksbridge
East Croydon	See how to get to Brighton station, then Southern or Thameslink train to East Croydon
Eastbourne	Bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), then bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne
Falmer	Bus 28, 29 or 29B from stop C to Falmer
Gatwick Airport	See how to get to Brighton station, then Southern or Thameslink train to Gatwick Airport
Glynde	Bus 125 (limited service) from the Bus Station to Glynde
Hampden Park	Bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne, then bus 'The Loop' to Hampden Park
Hastings	Bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne, then bus 98 or 99 to Hastings
Haywards Heath	Bus 166 (limited service) from stop C direct, OR see how to get to Brighton station, then Southern or Thameslink train to Haywards Heath
London Bridge	See how to get to Brighton station, then Southern or Thameslink train to London Bridge
London Road (Brighton)	Bus 28, 29 or 29B from stop C to Brighton (St Peter's Church) then bus 26, 46, 50 or 50U to London Road (Brighton) station (alight bus on Ditchling Road/Springfield Road)

London Victoria	See how to get to Brighton station, then Southern train to London Victoria
Moulsecoomb	Bus 28, 29 or 29B from stop C to Moulsecoomb (alight bus at Brighton University on Lewes Road)
Newhaven Harbour	See how to get to Newhaven Town station, it's a 10 minutes walk to Newhaven Harbour station
Newhaven Town	Bus 123 (limited service) from stop A to Newhaven, OR bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street) then bus 12 or 12A to Newhaven station or bus 12X or 13X to Newhaven Town Centre - Lower Place, 5 minutes walk to Newhaven Town station
Normans Bay	There are no practical public transport alternatives to this destination. If we are unable to run trains, we will do our best to run replacement buses, however there may be a long wait. If you are able to, we advise you to make your way to an alternative station
Pevensey & Westham	Bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne, then bus 55 or 56 to Pevensey & Westham station
Pevensey Bay	Bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne then bus 99 to Pevensey Bay
Plumpton	Bus 166 (limited service)
Polegate	Bus 125 (limited service) from the Bus Station, OR bus 28, 29 or 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne, then bus 51, 54, 54A, 56 or 98 to Polegate High Street near to station
Rye	Bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne, bus 99 to Hastings then bus 100 or 101 to Rye
St Leonards Warrior Square	Bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Eastbourne then bus 99 to St Leonards (Warrior Square)
Seaford	Bus 123 (limited service) from stop A to Newhaven then bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X, OR bus 28, 29 and 29B from stop C to Brighton (North Street), then bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Seaford
Southeast	Bus 123 (limited service) from stop A to Southeast village
Wivelsfield	Bus 166 (limited service) from stop C direct, OR see how to get to Brighton station, then Southern or Thameslink train to Wivelsfield
