Appledore There are no practical public transport alternatives to this destination. If we are unable to run trains, we will do our best to run replacement buses, however there may be a long wait. If you are able to, we advise you to make your own way to an alternative station

Ashford International Bus 100 or 101 from stop B to Folkestone bus station, then bus 16, 17, 71 or 73 to Folkestone Central station, then Southeastern train to Ashford International

Bexhill Bus 100 or 101 from stop A to Hastings station, then bus 98 or 99 to Bexhill station

Brighton Bus 100 or 101 from stop A to Hastings station, bus 99 to Eastbourne town centre, bus 12, 12A, 12X or 13X to Brighton (Old Steine), then bus 7 or 27 to Brighton station (early morning and evening 12/12A buses and all 13X buses run to Brighton station)

Doleham Bus 100 from stop A to Guestling Thorn, for Doleham station

Eastbourne Bus 100 or 101 from stop A to Hastings, then bus 99 to Eastbourne town centre/station

Ham Street There are no practical public transport alternatives to this destination. If we are unable to run trains, we will do our best to run replacement buses, however there may be a long wait. If you are able to, we advise you to make your own way to an alternative station

Hastings Bus 100 or 101 from stop A to Hastings station

Lewes See how to get to Brighton, then Southern train to Lewes or bus 28, 29 or 29B from Brighton Old Steine to Lewes

Ore Bus 100 or 101 from stop A to Ore village (Old London Road, near Post Office), then bus 22 or 22C to Mount Pleasant Road/Manor Road for Ore station

St Leonards Warrior Square Bus 100 or 101 from stop A to Hastings station, then Southern or Southeastern train, OR bus 20, 22/22A or 24 direct to the station (or bus 98 and 99 serve St Leonards seafront/Warrior Square, 10 minutes walk via Western Road to St Leonards Warrior Square station)

Three Oaks Bus 100 from stop A to Guestling Thorn, for Three Oaks station

Winchelsea Bus 100 from stop A to Winchelsea village
