Aldrington	Bus 46 from stop C or D to Aldrington, alight bus at Portland Road/Scott Road, it's a short walk via Tamworth Road to Aldrington station	Goring-by-Sea	Bus 700 from stop B to Goring-by-Sea
Angmering	Bus 700 from stop B to Rustington, Station Road for Angmering station	Havant	Bus 700 from stop B (change at Littlehampton and Chichester) to Havant
Barnham	There are no practical public transport alternatives to this destination. If we are unable to run trains, we will do our best to run replacement buses, however there may be a long wait. If you are able to, we advise you to make your way to an alternative station	Hove	Bus 46 from stop C or D or bus 700 from stop A to Hove (alight bus 46 at George Street and bus 700 at King Alfred Leisure Centre for Hove station)
Bognor Regis	Bus 700 from stop B (change at Littlehampton) to Bognor Regis	Lancing	Bus 700 from stop B to Lancing (alight bus at Brighton Road/The New Sussex Hotel), it's a 10 minutes walk via South Street to Lancing station
Brighton	Bus 46 from stop C or D or bus 700 from stop A to Brighton Churchill Square, then bus 6 to Brighton station	Littlehampton	Bus 700 from stop B to Littlehampton
Chichester	Bus 700 from stop B (change at Littlehampton) to Chichester	Portslade	Bus 46 from stop C or D or bus 700 from stop A to Portslade (alight bus 46 at Portslade station and bus 700 at Station Road/A259 coast road, it's a 10 minutes walk to Portslade station)
Durrington-on-Sea	Bus 700 from stop B to Durrington-on-Sea	Portsmouth & Southsea	Bus 700 (change at Littlehampton and Chichester) to Portsmouth City Centre (City Shops South) for Portsmouth & Southsea station
East Worthing	Bus 700 from stop B to East Worthing (alight bus on Brighton Road/Ham Road), 15 minutes walk via Ham Road to East Worthing station	Portsmouth Harbour	Bus 700 (change at Littlehampton and Chichester) to Portsmouth Harbour station (The Hard)
Emsworth	Bus 700 from stop B (change at Littlehampton and Chichester) to Emsworth	Shoreham-by-Sea	Bus 700 from stop B to Shoreham-by-Sea
Fareham	See how to get to Portsmouth & Southsea station, then South Western Railway or Great Western Railway train to Fareham	Southbourne	Bus 700 from stop B (change at Littlehampton and Chichester) to Southbourne
Fishersgate	Bus 700 from stop A to Fishersgate (alight bus at Albion Inn/A259 coast road), it's a short walk via West Road to Fishersgate station	Southampton Central	See how to get to Portsmouth & Southsea station, then South Western Railway or Great Western Railway train to Southampton Central
